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Notice Regarding the Impact of the 2026 Kumamoto Earthquake

We extend our deepest sympathies to all those affected by the “2026 Kumamoto Earthquake,” which occurred on July 28, 2026, with its epicenter in the Kumamoto region of Kumamoto Prefecture.

The XEBIO Group (the “Group”) is placing the highest priority on ensuring the safety of its customers and employees and is currently assessing the extent of damage to stores in the affected areas and undertaking recovery measures.

The current impact of the earthquake on the Group is as follows.

1. Status of Personal Injuries

Based on the information confirmed to date, no injuries to customers or employees have been reported.

The Group is continuing to confirm the safety of employees’ family members and the extent of damage to employees’ homes.

2. Status of Damage to Stores

Damage, including fallen or scattered merchandise, overturned fixtures, and cracks in floors, has been confirmed at certain stores in Kumamoto Prefecture. The Group is currently assessing the details and extent of the damage.

3. Status of Store Operations

To prevent secondary damage from aftershocks and to confirm the safety of the stores, the relevant stores in Kumamoto Prefecture were temporarily closed on July 29.

Store operations on and after July 30 will be determined on a store-by-store basis after confirming the safety of the stores and commercial facilities, employees’ ability to report to work, and the progress of recovery work. Stores located within commercial facilities will operate in accordance with the decisions of the respective facility operators.

The current operating status of each store is as follows:

The operating status of each store may change depending on the results of further safety inspections and the progress of recovery work.

The latest information regarding store operations will be posted on the websites of the relevant Group companies and on the webpages of the respective stores.

We sincerely apologize for the considerable concern and inconvenience caused to our customers. The Group will continue to make every effort to ensure store safety and facilitate recovery as quickly as possible.

4. Impact on Financial Results

The extent and monetary value of the damage caused by the earthquake, as well as its impact on the Group's financial results, are currently under investigation.

Should the earthquake be expected to have a material impact on the Group's financial results, the Company will promptly disclose the relevant information as necessary.
